**Camp Philosophy:** Hatch House Summer Camp is a blend of traditional summer camp activities, field trips with just a smidgen of "academics". Students explore new and exciting theme based activities while we sneak in, aka reinforce, basic classroom skills (writing, reading and math) based on the theme of the week. Our camp also provides a low teacher to camper ratio, fun curriculum themes, field trips, and guest visitors. The camp is primarily geared towards children who have completed Kindergarten through 6th grade. Daily camp activities are held at the Hatch House School building. Camp Hatch House will provide a memorable and meaningful summer experience with a smaller group, in an engaging and safe environment.

**Staff:** All camp staff are experienced and undergo Department of Family and Protective Services background checks, and FBI fingerprinting checks in addition to being CPR/First-Aid certified.



Hatch House School is licensed by the Texas Department of Family and Protective Services to provide care for children who are infants to school-aged children.

## What Does the Camp experience Offer:

- Low camper to teacher ratios
- Academic enrichment periods. Yes, we read, write and do some math everyday
- Weekly local field trips and water play at splash pads
- Experienced & qualified staff

## WEEKLY CAMP THEMES

**Week 1: All About Me:** This week we are focusing on the super fantastic you! This is the week where we meet all of our new summer camp friends and learn about our differences and similarities and how to work as a team. We will make a book about You, visit the park, have splash day, and Kona Ice will visit.

**Week 2: Bugging Out on Animal Planet:** Exploring the animal kingdom is a great way for engaging students and developing a connection to the animal world. Campers will learn and research different animals in our region.

**Week 3: Everything is Bigger In Texas:** Campers will explore and learn all about the city of Austin, Texas. They will visit local attractions, and generally learn about the history, geography and life in our "keeping it weird" city.

**Week 4: Project Fun-way:** Learn the art of performing. During this camp students will make props, learn how to prepare a stage, write and learn their lines, practice a dance or song, and prepare for a memorable performance for friends and family at the end of the week. Academy awards anyone?



**Week 5: Inventors Workshop/Shark Tank:** No falling asleep in class anymore with all the amazing experiments and inventions that campers will get to do. This is a hands on camp where your child will forget that they are doing science.

**Week 6: Once Upon a Time:** This week we are all about Fairytale! Have you ever thought of making a fairytale have a different ending or beginning? Students will make props, learn to speak on stage, write lines, and preform a unique fairytale show at the end of the week.

**Week 7: When I Grow Up:** Prompting kids to dream about what they want to be when they grow up will help them to think about the future more than just the present, and is a perfect opportunity to talk about goals and future career possibilities.

**Week 8: Space Jam:** This week we are looking into space for some solar fun. How much do you know about our solar system, or the stars that fill the night sky? Are you interested in space travel, astronauts and space ships and the science of space? then get ready to learn about space.

**Week 9: Food Network Kids Cooking:** Do you enjoy learning about cooking tasty, easy, kid-friendly meals? Are you a budding junior chef? In this camp we will mix, mold and make summertime food and refreshing summertime drinks. We will learn about cooking terms, baking, measurements and recipes.

**Week 10: Around the World in 5 Days:** Our world explorers camp is a great way to teach geography skills and expose children to other cultures. Most importantly, you can nurture a love for exploration and a sense of respect and empathy for other ways of life. Through simple crafts and fun activities you can spark curiosity about other cultures and set the foundation for further exploration.

**Week 11: Back to School Countdown:** This week we are looking ahead. The new school year is just around the corner. The activities this week are designed to help prepare your child and spark their excitement for the first day of school. Good-bye summer, hello Fall!

## What to Bring

All campers should bring a water bottle filled with cold water, sunscreen, wear closed toed shoes, and comfortable clothing. The teachers will inform parents on the days campers need to bring anything special, like a swim suit or sack lunch. Please label all of your children's belongings so that they make it home at the end of the day. Please don't send any toys, electronic games, or money unless requested to do so. Please do not send your child to school with any items that are irreplaceable.

## Behavioral Expectations

Campers are expected to behave appropriately at all times. Hatch House School reserves the right to cancel or dismiss a child's enrollment at anytime, at its sole discretion. We also reserve the right to not enroll a child whose behaviors or needs we are unable to meet if we deem such action to be in the best interest of the child and/or school.

## Health Considerations

If a camper encounters a health problem during the day, we will immediately notify the parent/guardian. If you cannot be reached, we will contact the emergency contacts listed on the registration form. If your child has any preexisting medical conditions or medications that require daily administration please notify the Director prior to enrollment. All allergy medications and physician directives must be provided upon enrollment.

## Registration & Tuition Fees

**Registration and Field Trips Fee:** \$75 (non-refundable registration fee due upon enrollment).

**Weekly Tuition Fee:** \$195 per week session\* full-time, Monday to Friday. Registration and tuition fees must be received in advance so that we can plan for the upcoming week. Lunch, morning snack and afternoon snack are included. Some field trips may require a sack lunch from home or parent-pay take-out restaurant meals depending on the week.

\* The only exception to the weekly tuition is the last week of camp which is only 3 days (Monday August 12 through Wednesday August 14). Tuition for this last 3 days of camps is a DAILY fee of \$40 per day.

**Specialized Enrichment Programs:** A separate fee may be required to participate in specialized programs from outside enrichment vendors (for example Drones, or Karate etc.).

*Please select camps carefully. Camp tuition fees are NOT refundable or transferable. Parents are financially responsible for the camps they have selected.*
